2008 World Men's Curling Championship

The 2008 World Men's Curling Championship will bring together the best curlers from around the world. Twelve men's teams, all national champions from the United States, Canada, Europe and the Pacific Rim, will vie for the title of "World Champion."

Medora Musical – June 1st through August 31st

Medora - This Broadway-style musical show is staged in the spectacular Burning Hills Amphitheatre. The surrounding hills resound with music and laughter at this fast paced, song-and-dance professional extravaganza.

Norsk Høstfest – September 30th - October 4th

Minot - The Northern Plains' largest ethnic festival draws thousands of people to Minot for Scandinavian and American entertainment, Scandinavian delicacies, arts and crafts exhibits and dignitaries representing Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Iceland and Finland. Big-name entertainment nightly.

United Tribes International Powwow – September 4th – 7th

Bismarck - Contest powwow attracts hundreds of American Indian dancers, dozens of drum groups, showcase of American Indian culture, home of the champions.

Buggies-n-Blues June 7th & 8th

Mandan - Main Street -Various business activities, dance at Burlington Northern Park, concession and beer garden. Classic car show. Approximately 500 vehicles, music, food, and beer garden. www.buggies-n-blues.org

Fort Union Trading Post Rendezvous - June 19th - 22nd

Near Williston - 19th century fur trade fair, includes a variety of historic period arts, crafts and music. www.nps.gov/fous

Fort Seward Wagon Train – June 29th – July 5th

Embarks every year from Fort Seward Site in Jamestown on a trek through history. The wagon train is dedicated to recreating a time in our state's - and our nation's - history for anyone who wants to experience it. http://covered-wagon-train.com

Mandan Rodeo Days Celebration - July 1st - 4th

Celebrating its 130th year, this Wild West show attracts more than 30,000 spectators who gather to watch determined cowboys pitted against bucking bulls and broncos, as well as cowgirls manoeuvring trained barrel-racing horses, rodeo clowns and chuck-wagon races.

Roughriders Days Fair and Expo – July 3rd - July 5th

Dickinson - Rodeos, fireworks, parade, X-treme power sport show, demolition derby, concerts and drag races are all held during this Independence week along with horseshow, commercial and livestock exhibits. www.roughriderdaysfair.com

85th Annual Killdeer Mountain Roundup Rodeo - July 3-4

The oldest PRCA rodeo in the state includes parade, barbecue, street dances and other events for all ages. www.killdeer.com

Spirit of the West – August 1st - 3rd

Beach - Three days of great music, rodeo action, kids activities, street dances, golf tourney, 5K walk/run, pitchfork fondue, talent show and big name concert. Event includes the Champions Ride Saddle Bronc Match, Sentinel Butte. www.spiritofthewest.us

Little Shell Powwow, New Town - August 8th - 10th

Little Shell Powwow held at the powwow grounds 4 miles west of New Town. Traditional dancing.
